DOG-FRIENDLY ICE LOLLY RECIPE

A perfect treat to help keep cool on those hot summer days

A pot of live plain yoghurt (no sugar, no sweetener)

1 banana

1 teaspoon of honey

1 large carrot

- Using a hand blender, blend the yoghurt, sliced banana and honey, making sure that the banana is well 'mushed'.
- Spoon mixture into suitable ice-lolly sized pots. Small or shot glasses, or egg cups would be suitable.
- Slice the carrots into batons, to act as your edible lolly sticks so should have enough length to hold when you place them into your yoghurt mixture.
- Carefully place one carrot stick, vertically, into the centre of each pot.
- Place pots in freezer. The length of time your dog ice lollies take to freeze will depend on their size, but should be ready in 4-5 hours
- When your dog is ready to enjoy its ice lolly, run the mould under a little warm water and slide the lolly out.

Tips:

In addition to, or in place of, the banana, you could try other ingredients such as berries, apples (no pips or core), cucumber, mango or peanut butter (no salt and no xylitol or other artificial sweeteners, as these are very toxic to dogs)

Remember, these dog ice lollies are treats and should be given sparingly as part of your dog's usual food allowance.

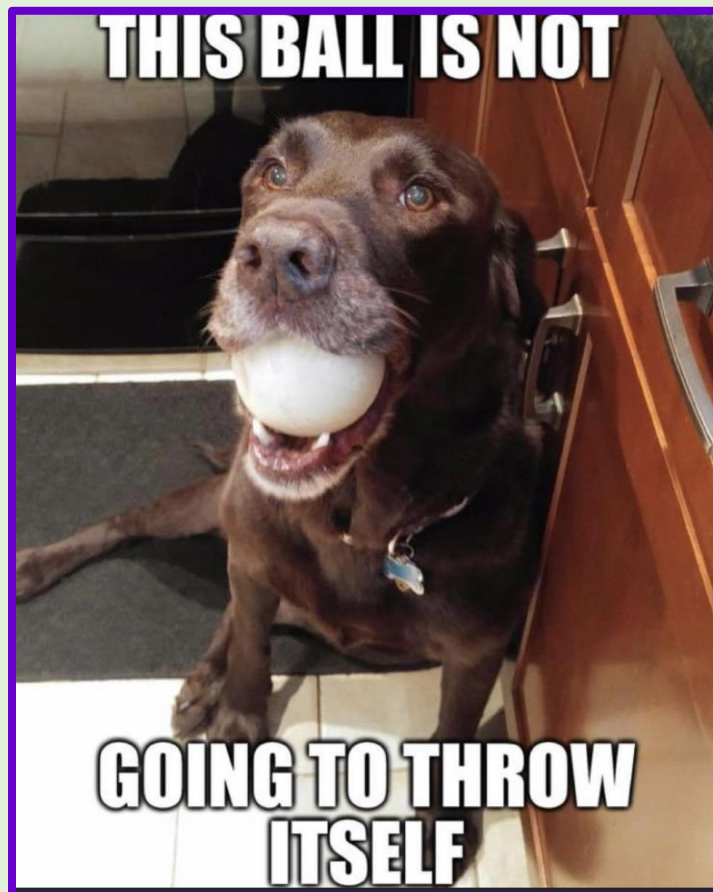

OAK (formerly BOWBOW)

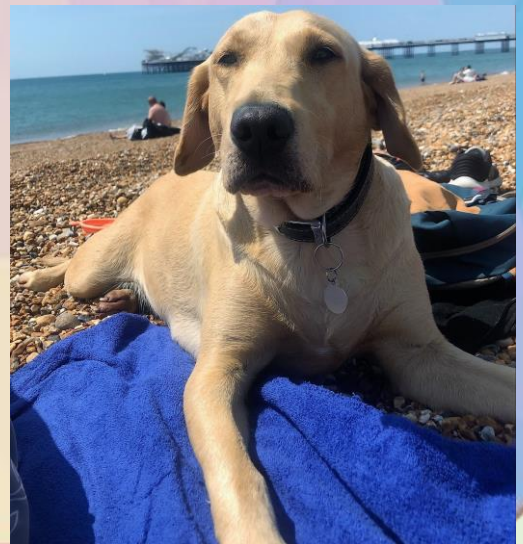


Hey Sue,

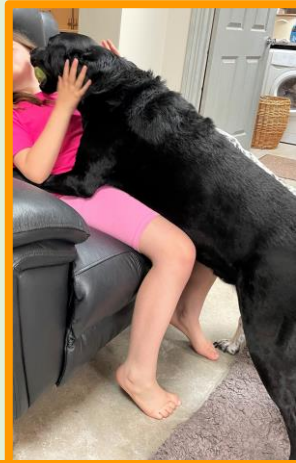
Our stock frequently runs low, and they are quite expensive for us to replace.

TRAVELLING WITH DOGS IN CARS

- 34% of drivers don't use a dog car seat, harness, crate or belt for their dog when driving. That's a 1/3 of all dogs travelling in a dangerous manner.
- 1 in every 10 drivers lets their dog sit in the front passenger seat
- Transporting your dog without a suitable restraint could leave you with 9 points on your license
- Transporting your dog without a suitable restraint could also result in a £2500 fine
- 64% of drivers are unaware of the above
- Driving with your dog without a suitable restraint could invalidate your insurance

DARCY

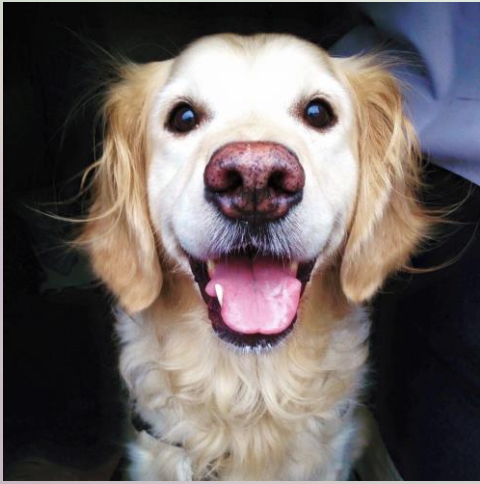


Hi Sue,

Warning signs of heatstroke in dogs, and how to prevent it

As it heats up across the country, here is a reminder of the symptoms of heatstroke in dogs and how to prevent it.

- Heavy panting and difficulty breathing
- Excessive drooling
- Collapse or vomiting
- Lethargy, drowsiness or a lack of co-ordination

Prevention:

- Walk your dog at dawn or dusk, during the coolest part of the day
- If you're attending an outdoor event with your dog, make sure there is plenty of fresh water, shade and a cool surface for your dog to walk on

But ultimately if it's just too hot, then it's best for your dog to stay at home. Remember that dogs don't die from not having a walk, but they do from heatstroke
