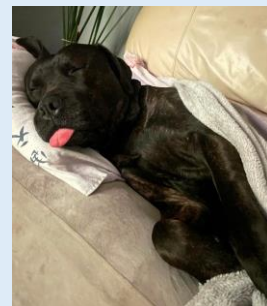
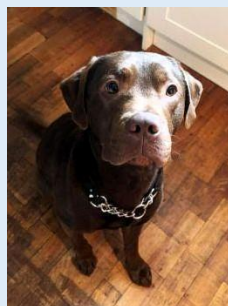




Welcome to our March Newsletter.

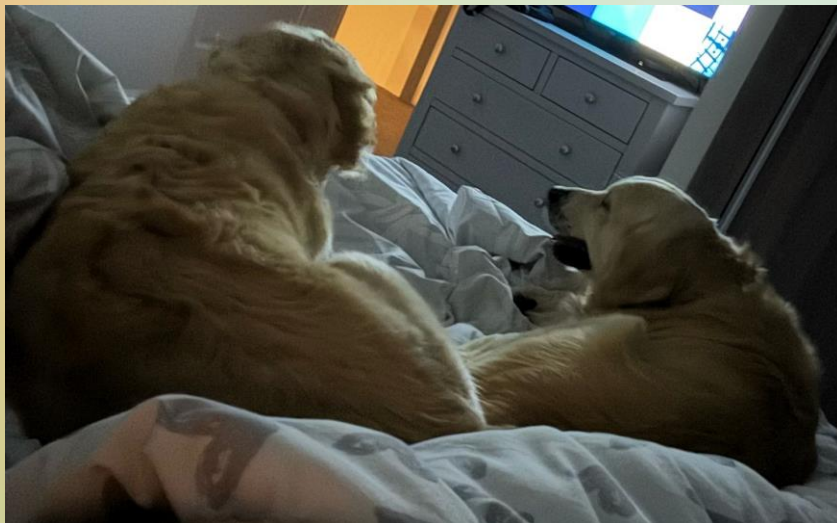
RODNEY & DOLLY
