## **Morning Louise**




# MARGO




# MONTY

Good afternoon Sue,



We've just celebrated six months of Ray-doggie joining the family, so it's update time!


Ray has settled happily into our daily routine-it feels like he's always been here. He is a bouncy, bright, wonderful addition to our family, and we love him to bits.

# LENNY




Hi Sue I hope you're well.
